- At first he *called/was called* Mortimer Mouse.
- He *gave/was given* the name Mickey by Walt Disney's wife, Lillian.
- Disney *made/was made* the first full-length cartoon, Snow White, in 1937.

Put the verb in brackets in the correct tense. They are all in the passive.
